At Living Memorial Park you may see people using snowboards, alpine, telemark, cross-country or other specialized ski equipment. Regardless of how you enjoy the hill, you should always show courtesy to others and be aware that there are elements of risk in snowboarding or skiing that can be reduced through common sense and attentiveness. Observe the code below and share the responsibility for a great skiing and riding experience.

- Always know your limits. Stay in control and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
- People in front of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
- You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- When starting downhill, look uphill and yield to others.
- Always use devices to prevent runaway equipment.
- Observe all posted signs and warnings, Keep off closed areas.
- Prior to using the lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.

This is a partial list. Be safety conscious. Riders and skiers who do not abide by the park rules and the code run the risk of having their skiing and riding privileges revoked.
