

LMPSS, INC Policy for Community Service Volunteers

High school students are eligible to earn community service credits by working for LMPSS, INC. (Snow Sports). Each hour of service translates to 1 credit. Students must submit an annual application and be trained before service begins. Applications, signed by a member of the snow sports board, will be kept on record. Students may receive a voucher (free ticket) to use the lift for the balance of any day on which they have served a shift.

In season, community service volunteers work under the direction of the Base Station manager and may be directed to:

- Load passengers in the lift
- Assist new riders in how to ride the lift
- Maintain the condition of the lift line
- Sell Tickets
- Communicate with the Castle
- Keep the lift line organized
- Turn on/off lights
- Spruce up the warming hut
- Sell/inventory snacks
- Position signs and benches
- And perform any other basic duties in and around the Base Station.

Community service volunteers will not be directed to replace any “adult” role or to perform any task for which there is no direct adult supervision. CS volunteers can help with setup/take down during snowmaking operations under adult supervision.

Off season, community service volunteers work under the direction of Snow Sports Board members and may be asked to participate in group activities, i.e. putting up/taking down T’s, representing Snow Sports in local activities, etc. At no time will community service volunteers be signed out to perform a service without prior notification and documented consent by at least 3 members of the Board.
